Background of the Project with Problem:

The Ramnath Prasad Institute of Higher Education Foundation, East Champaran, Bihar, was established with the vision of promoting education, healthcare, and social welfare among underserved rural communities. Despite significant progress in public health programs across India, many villages in East Champaran continue to face limited access to affordable healthcare facilities, essential medicines, diagnostic services, and emergency medical support. Residents often travel long distances to reach hospitals located in urban centers, resulting in delayed treatment, increased healthcare costs, and poor health outcomes, particularly among economically weaker sections, women, children, and elderly citizens.

Recognizing these challenges, the Foundation initiated the development of the proposed Ramnath Prasad Hospital on a land parcel of approximately 11,000 square feet in Bela, East Champaran. During the financial year 2025–26, preliminary infrastructure development activities were undertaken, including land development and earth filling, boundary wall construction, and completion of a two-room facility intended for the operation of a Jan Aushadhi Kendra (Pharmacy Unit). These capital development activities have been reflected in the Foundation's audited financial statements for FY 2025–26.

The project aims to address the shortage of accessible and affordable healthcare services in the region by creating a community-based healthcare institution. Upon completion, the hospital and Jan Aushadhi Kendra are expected to improve healthcare accessibility, ensure the availability of low-cost medicines, generate local employment opportunities, and contribute to the overall social and economic development of East Champaran.

Project Objectives

Project Objectives

The primary objective of the Ramnath Prasad Institute of Higher Education Foundation is to strengthen healthcare accessibility and improve the quality of life for rural populations in East Champaran, Bihar. The Foundation has initiated the development of the proposed Ramnath Prasad Hospital with the aim of establishing a modern, affordable, and community-oriented healthcare facility that can address the growing medical needs of the region.

The project seeks to provide accessible primary and secondary healthcare services, reduce dependency on distant urban hospitals, and ensure timely medical intervention for local residents. Another key objective is to facilitate the availability of affordable and quality medicines through the establishment of a Jan Aushadhi Kendra, thereby reducing the financial burden of healthcare on economically disadvantaged families.

The Foundation also aims to create a sustainable healthcare infrastructure by developing an 11,000 sq. ft. hospital campus equipped for future expansion, including outpatient services, diagnostic facilities, pharmacy services, maternal and child healthcare, and emergency medical support. During FY 2025–26, significant progress was made through land development, earth filling, boundary wall construction, and the completion of a two-room pharmacy facility, laying the groundwork for future operations.

Ultimately, the project aspires to promote health equity, enhance community well-being, generate local employment opportunities, and contribute to the long-term socio-economic development of East Champaran and surrounding rural areas.

Project Activities and Implementation

Project Activities and Implementation

During the financial year 2025–26, the Ramnath Prasad Institute of Higher Education Foundation undertook several strategic activities aimed at establishing the foundation for the proposed Ramnath Prasad Hospital and associated healthcare services in Bela, East Champaran, Bihar. The project was conceptualized in response to the growing need for accessible, affordable, and quality healthcare facilities in rural areas where residents often face challenges in obtaining timely medical treatment and essential medicines.

The first phase of project implementation focused on identifying and securing suitable land for the development of the proposed hospital campus. A land parcel measuring approximately 11,000 square feet was selected for the project, considering factors such as accessibility, future expansion potential, and proximity to the target beneficiary population. The Foundation completed the necessary planning and administrative processes to facilitate the acquisition and registration of the property for healthcare development purposes.

Following site identification, significant efforts were directed toward land development and site preparation activities. The project area required leveling and earth filling to create a stable and safe platform for future construction. Large quantities of soil were transported and compacted across the site to improve the land profile, reduce uneven surfaces, and prepare the area for structural development. These activities also contributed to improved drainage and site usability during different weather conditions.

Another major component of the implementation process involved the construction of a boundary wall around the project premises. The boundary wall was developed to secure the property, prevent unauthorized access, protect future infrastructure investments, and establish a clearly defined institutional campus. This activity represents an important step toward safeguarding the project site and ensuring compliance with long-term development plans.

Recognizing the immediate healthcare and pharmaceutical needs of the local population, the Foundation simultaneously initiated the development of a two-room building facility for a Jan Aushadhi Kendra (Pharmacy Unit). The construction of this facility was completed during the reporting period and is intended to support the distribution of affordable generic medicines under the Government of India's Jan Aushadhi initiative. The pharmacy unit is expected to serve as an important healthcare access point for nearby communities while complementing the future operations of the proposed hospital.

The implementation process was carried out through continuous monitoring by the Foundation's management and project team. Site visits, construction supervision, resource planning, and expenditure monitoring were conducted to ensure that activities progressed according to approved plans and available financial resources. The Foundation mobilized funds through donations, membership contributions, and public support to finance the project activities and infrastructure development work undertaken during the year. According to the audited financial statements, capital expenditures were incurred for land development and earth filling, boundary wall construction, and construction of the two-room facility, reflecting the Foundation's commitment to creating sustainable healthcare infrastructure for the community.

Overall, the activities completed during FY 2025–26 represent the successful completion of the initial phase of the project. These developments have established the physical foundation necessary for future hospital construction and healthcare service delivery, bringing the Foundation closer to its vision of improving healthcare accessibility and community welfare in East Champaran.

During the financial year 2025–26, the Ramnath Prasad Institute of Higher Education Foundation achieved significant progress toward its long-term vision of establishing accessible and affordable healthcare infrastructure in East Champaran, Bihar. Although the proposed Ramnath Prasad Hospital is still under development, the activities completed during the reporting period have generated important outcomes that will facilitate future healthcare service delivery and community development.

One of the most notable outcomes was the successful preparation of the proposed hospital site. Through extensive land development and earth-filling activities, the Foundation transformed the selected land parcel into a suitable location for future construction. The site is now better prepared for structural development, reducing potential construction challenges and enabling smoother implementation of upcoming project phases. The development of approximately 11,000 square feet of land represents a major milestone toward the establishment of a permanent healthcare institution in the region.

Another important achievement was the completion of the boundary wall surrounding the project area. This infrastructure has enhanced the security and protection of the property, safeguarding current and future investments. The defined campus boundary has also improved project management, site organization, and readiness for subsequent construction activities.

A key outcome of the project was the construction of a two-room facility intended for the establishment of a Jan Aushadhi Kendra. This infrastructure creates the foundation for providing affordable generic medicines to local residents, particularly those belonging to economically weaker sections of society. Once operational, the pharmacy unit is expected to reduce healthcare expenditure for families and improve access to essential medicines within the community.

The project has also strengthened community confidence and stakeholder engagement. Local residents have expressed positive expectations regarding the future hospital and pharmacy services, recognizing their potential to reduce dependence on distant healthcare facilities. The visible progress achieved during the year has increased awareness about the Foundation's commitment to social welfare and rural healthcare development.

From an institutional perspective, the project has enhanced the Foundation's capacity to implement large-scale community development initiatives. The successful mobilization and utilization of financial resources for infrastructure creation demonstrate effective planning and project management. According to the audited financial statements, investments were made in land development, boundary wall construction, and building construction for healthcare-related purposes, establishing valuable assets for future operations.

Overall, the outcomes achieved during FY 2025–26 have laid a strong foundation for the future development of Ramnath Prasad Hospital and Jan Aushadhi Kendra. These achievements represent an important step toward improving healthcare accessibility, promoting community well-being, and supporting sustainable socio-economic development in East Champaran.

Conclusion and Future Plans

The financial year 2025–26 marked an important milestone for the Ramnath Prasad Institute of Higher Education Foundation in its mission to promote community welfare and improve access to healthcare services in East Champaran, Bihar. Through the successful implementation of preliminary infrastructure activities, the Foundation has established a strong foundation for the proposed Ramnath Prasad Hospital and associated healthcare initiatives. Key achievements during the year included land development and earth filling, construction of a boundary wall for site security, and completion of a two-room facility intended for the establishment of a Jan Aushadhi Kendra. These developments demonstrate the Foundation's commitment to creating sustainable healthcare infrastructure that addresses the needs of underserved rural populations.

The progress achieved during the reporting period has transformed the project from a conceptual initiative into a tangible community development undertaking. The infrastructure created to date has enhanced the readiness of the project site for future expansion and has generated confidence among local stakeholders regarding the Foundation's long-term vision. While the hospital is not yet operational, the groundwork completed during FY 2025–26 represents a critical step toward the realization of affordable and accessible healthcare services for the people of Bela and surrounding areas.

Looking ahead, the Foundation plans to complete the registration process of the hospital land in the name of Ramnath Prasad Hospital and initiate the next phase of infrastructure development. Future activities will include preparation of architectural plans, construction of hospital buildings, development of essential utilities, procurement of medical equipment, and establishment of healthcare service units. The Foundation also aims to operationalize the Jan Aushadhi Kendra to provide affordable medicines to the community at the earliest opportunity.

In the long term, the Foundation envisions developing a comprehensive healthcare institution offering outpatient services, diagnostic facilities, pharmacy services, maternal and child healthcare, preventive health programs, and emergency medical support. Through continued community participation, donor support, and strategic planning, the Foundation remains committed to improving healthcare accessibility, enhancing quality of life, and contributing to the socio-economic development of East Champaran and neighboring regions.
